General Comment

Kawasaki Motors Manufacturing offers their support for the comments that were submitted by the NAFTAZ on May 4, 2011. The NAFTAZ has pored over the proposed regulations, has discussed the issues with their membership, and has professionally prepared suggested changes to the proposed regulations. Of particular concern to our company are the proposed regulation changes at section 400.14. As a company who manufactures our products in a foreign-trade subzone, we feel the proposed regulations would create a large burden for us due to the significant reporting and approvals that would be required related to changes in antidumping/countervailing duty, sourcing, capacity, and duty rates. We agree with the NAFTAZ approach by changing the application process so that applications are focused on the production or manufacturing of intermediate and finished products, without specific reference to all of the materials and parts utilized.

Kawasaki endorses the entirety of the NAFTAZ's suggested changes.
